



2021-2022 Fee Structure

Tuition

Tuition fees may be paid in full or Installments by Pre-Authorized Debit. A deposit equal to 10% of the total fee is required at the time of registration. This deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. The balance of the tuition is paid in **10 monthly instalments** from September 2021-June 2022.

New Applicant Fee

Non-refundable, one-time fee due at the time of registration \$200.00

Discounts

- Second Sibling Discount: Families will receive a credit \$750.00 toward their second tuition fee. An equal portion of this credit will be applied to the monthly tuition, by the registrar.
- Third Sibling Discount: Families will receive a credit of 10% toward their third tuition fee. An equal portion of this credit will be applied to the monthly tuition, by the registrar.
